



Summer Camp Policies

The Dance Works will be offering several opportunities for summer dance! Half day themed camps, in addition to a Eight week session of classes. Our eight week session runs from June 13 thru July 29th.

PAYMENT: A non-refundable deposit of \$75.00 per camp is due at the time of registration in order to secure your child's camp spot. The remaining balance will be due 30 days prior to the camp. Payments may be made by check, cash or credit card. There is a convenience fee added to all credit transactions. A \$10.00 late fee will be applied to all late accounts. A \$30.00 returned check fee will be applied on all returned checks.

MINIMUM ENROLLMENT: Camps must have a minimum of 6 – 8 dancers to run during the summer. If a camp has not met this minimum two weeks prior to the camp start date, then The Dance Works may cancel or combine the camp. If this happens, all families will be refunded or credited the total amount paid for the camp. We never want to cancel a camp, so invite all of your friends!

ATTENDANCE: Attendance is taken at the beginning of each day. If you are aware of an absence or your child is sick, please call or email the studio and let us know. Camps do not offer make-ups. Absences do not qualify for tuition refunds.

SNACKS: Healthy snacks will be provided for your dancer. We encourage your child to bring a water bottle to camp. Please let us know if your child has any food allergies. Breaks will be offered each day in camp.

DRESS CODE POLICY: We have a flexible dress code policy during the summer months at the studio for our dance camps. For our dancers taking technical classes there is a dress code policy of Black leotard of any style, pink tights for ballet classes and black or tan tights for tap/jazz. Appropriate dance shoes must be worn. Black tap shoes, pink ballet shoes and black jazz shoes. Please check with us at the studio if you have dance attire questions.

PARENT OBSERVATION: We want our students to learn in the best possible environment, and we want you to see their progress! Closed circuit televisions allow you to watch your child's class in our café/lobby. Please do not enter the classrooms during class time unless invited by your child instructor.

STUDENT CONDUCT: All students are expected to arrive to class on time and should always behave in a respectful and appropriate manner. Students will be asked to leave class or observe if behavior is deemed in appropriate.

DISRUPTIVE BEHAVIOR POLICY: We make every effort to work with the children to encourage personal responsibility for their behavior/actions while they are in the classrooms. We do take into account their age, but do expect the rules to be followed. In the event that behavior is disrupting class it may result in the following: (1) Not getting a stamp or sticker (2) Initial Consultation w/Student and Parents (3) Dismissal policy (detailed below)

The Dance Works reserved the right to refuse service to anyone. The studio reserves the right to cancel the enrollment of a child for the following reasons: (1) Non-payment or excessive late payment of fees. (2) Not observing the rules and/or policies of the studio. (3) Physical and/or verbal abuse of staff or children by a parent or a child.

MEDICAL ATTENTION/ALLERGIES: If your dancer has any medical problems, conditions, or concerns or has any particular type of allergy, that would affect their performance in the classroom, please let us know.

LOBBY RULES: (1) Students MUST wait inside the building to be picked up. (2) No student is permitted to wait outside the building without an adult. (3) All students should use the restroom before entering class. (4) Please try to keep the lobby as quiet and clean as possible. (5) Please do not interrupt the teachers while in class, all communication should be sent to the director. (6) The Dance Works is in no way responsible for unsupervised children.
